

WHAT'S NEEDED?

Tools:

- Nylon mallet (not included)
- Philips head screwdriver or drill (not included)
- Allen keys (included in blister pack)

THIS MODULE IS PACKED IN THREE BOXES: **BOX 1 OF 3 = STONE TOP**

STONE TOP

BOX 2 OF 3 = BBQ MODULE PANELS & FRAMES

- PVC & THERMAL PANELS AND FRAMES
- HARDWARE BLISTER PACK
- PLINTH FFFT

BOX 3 OF 3 = DOORS

Essential Tip: Ensure you have a stable, flat surface to knock your modules together on; ideally concrete.

LAYOUT DIAGRAM




BBQ MODULE ASSEMBLY

NOTE: Assemble the module on its side.









NOTE: Now turn module 90 degrees onto its base

ASSEMBLING PLINTH FEET & KICK PLATE

There are no pilot holes provided for fitting the plinth feet, use the inside of the frame edge as a guide.


Place plinth foot into corner of cabinet frame. Secure with screws provided. If easier, remove plinth shaft from baseplate, then screw down base plate first. If desired, move the front two plinth feet further back to create a deeper kick-plate position.






ATTACHING THE KICK PLATE

Please take note that the kick plate provided is reversible, giving you the choice between a black finish or stylish silver finish. The kick plate biscuit is used to connect and align adjoining kick plate.





Choose the desired colour face of kick plate (silver or black).

No pre-drilled holes are possible due to this colour option. Self tapping screws are provided to attach the spring clip base to the kick panel.

The dimensions on FIG. 10 can be used as a guide only since the position of the plinth foot and the desired depth of the kick plate will vary depending on the plinth foot installation position by the end user.




ASSEMBLING DOOR & HINGES

- To attach the hinge plate use a standard or power Phillips head screw driver. The holes are pre-drilled into the frame.
- Attach all six-hinge plates when attaching two doors.






DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO CLIP ON THE DOORS USING CLIP-ON-HINGES



Clip On hinge Instructions:

Clamp hinge on to the mounting plate as shown by direction arrow

Press down the hinge arm to lock the plate as shown

The door can be quickly removed by pushing the button

Unclipping the door from the mounting plate leaves all adjustments unaltered

Firstly align the front hinge section with the front section of the hinge-plate, then press on the back of the hinge-plate, an audible "click" should be heard if the door has been correctly hanged. Repeat the process to secure the bottom hinge and door.



The door should fully open and close as normal.



At this stage your progress should look like the above image.


ATTACHING & LEVELLING THE MODULES

Position modules in the desired configurations. Level each module and ensure the heights are correct so that joining holes line up. Now join the two modules with the barrel bolts supplied. Do not over tighten barrel bolts. Position and level the whole assembly when in final position.



Make sure the cabinets are leveled and aligned, ready to be connected by barrel bolts.

Please note: insert the biscuit into the slot in the kick plate, then align the kick plate ready to be connected.






Cabinet joined with barrel bolts.



Note: The door is not shown in some images to illustrate the cabinet connection method more clearly.

STONE TOP PLACEMENT

Use self-taping screws supplied with stone top. Align the pre-drilled pilot holes in the stone and top of module and fasten screws.

Please note: there is a 30mm front overhang.



HOW TO INSTALL A DOOR HANDLE



Additional screws are provided for a very secure connection, although you need to drill your own holes due to the handle having multiple possible positions as desired. These additional screw fixtures and not required under normal use.



IMPORTANT

• 3.2mm drill bit with a depth stop (not supplied).

Please ensure you use a stop or tape on the drill bit, so not to drill deeper than 9mm maximum into the door. Damage to the door from incorrect drilling will not be covered under warranty.

Use tape to set the depth to 9mm max.


